Bubup Wilam, "Children's Place" in Woi Wurrung language is an Aboriginal Community Controlled Child and Family Centre run by the community, for the community. Through a long day care and kindergarten service Bubup Wilam aims to nurture strong, proud and healthy kids in a culturally rich and supportive educational environment. This equates to children taking a lead responsibility in owning and developing their play, space, interaction, learning, and engagement with others in a confident and supported way. We aim to ensure our children, at a very early age, begin the journey in reaching their full human potential.

Woven and embedded into our Aboriginal Early Years environment, Bubup Wilam delivers a holistic, strengths-based, family-focused approach to health and wellbeing through a range of programs and services that extend into primary school.

Programs at Bubup Wilam

Health & Wellbeing Program

Our professional health and well-being team are employed by Bubup Wilam to work holistically on the ground with educators, children and their families within the education environment to capture the whole child. We provide a range of wrap-around services to children and families enrolled at Bubup Wilam including speech pathology, health checks, maternal and child health program, and social and emotional wellbeing support and advocacy.

Bubup Wilam is an NDIS provider of Early Childhood Intervention Services (ECIS). These services can be accessed by the broader Aboriginal community as well as enrolled children and families.

Transition to School Program

We follow children's learning journeys from when they leave Bubup Wilam into Primary School and beyond.

Workforce Development Program

We grow our own workforce to look after our own children. Bubup Wilam provides onsite Certificate III and Diploma level training in Early Childhood Education and Care as well as short courses and professional development opportunities for staff and the broader community.
